Presenting a crucial session for all parents.

Your family and your school community need you to attend.

Over 600 teenagers are injured (or worse) on our roads each year - You can do something about it!

If your child has their Learners Licence (or is due to get it in the coming year) then this will be an essential session for you as a parent or carer.

Parents are most likely to provide much of the driver education for their child, think about this;

- Do you know how to develop and build their driving experiences?
- Do you know how to reduce the risk of crashing or change the severity of the outcome?
- Are you really prepared for the task of supervising a novice driver?
- Have you kept up to date with road rule changes?
- Do you know what to look for in a Driving Instructor?
- Do you know what to look for regarding your child's first car?

Many South Australians believe that road fatalities and serious injuries are the result of risk taking or extreme behaviours. However, research shows that more than half of fatal crashes and 90% of injury crashes are due to mistakes, inattention or common lapses in judgement. **Researchers believe that too many young drivers are not being taught well enough or equipped with enough skills and knowledge to drive safely.**

Simply increasing awareness of the dangers of high-risk driving does not necessarily lead to less risky behaviours. Save A Life Australia (an independent road safety company that developed and delivers this program) has developed a longer-term approach, which we believe will help to make our families safer on the road.

This highly acclaimed program is coming to our school. The program involves students AND parents and is presented by Darren Davis (Get Home Safe Foundation President and regular Road Safety expert for ABC, 5aa and Channel 7).

It is essential that you attend our parents/supervising drivers evening session and help to make our whole school community more aware of how to make our new drivers better equipped for a safe driving future!

The parent's session will last for approximately one hour and is an informal discussion-based session that could make a real difference to your family. **No Driving Instructor or driving school will be advertised at any time. This session is to help parents with their choices.**


