As an independent contractor, the Cricket Coach supports and enhances the continued development of our program. Scope of Services to be provided include:

- In collaboration with the Cricket Coordinator, deliver the Rostrevor 'Game Style' and 'Values & Behaviours', focusing on holistic development of student-athletes as both players and individuals.
- Attend all First XI matches, training sessions, pre-season trials, and key cricket-related events from the commencement to the conclusion of the College cricket season.
- Deliver a high-performance coaching program in partnership with the Cricket Coordinator and Senior Cricket Coaches to support elite player development.
- Create a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable training and playing environment that promotes a team-first mindset and a culture of success.
- Serve as a role model by demonstrating respect, integrity, and professionalism in all interactions with players, parents, staff, umpires, and fellow coaches.
- Maintain clear and consistent communication on and off the field, with a strong emphasis on individual and team development.
- Implement a structured approach to performance feedback, encouraging reflection and learning for both players and coaching staff.
- Deliver cricket education using varied teaching methods (e.g. hands-on activities, visual aids, walk-throughs, discussions) to cater to different learning styles.

 - Training: Tuesdays and Thursdays, approx. 3:30 – 5:00 p.m. (3 hours total per week)
 - Matches: Fridays, approx. 3:30 – 7:00 p.m. (3.5 hours), and Saturdays, approx. 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. (7 hours)
