The Catherine Mary Enright Kelly (CMEK) Scholarship

The Catherine Mary Enright Kelly (CMEK) Scholarship is supported by the CMEK bequest, made to Rostrevor College at an assembly in 1959 by Mr Thomas D Kelly M.S, F.R.C.S, F.R.A.C.S, F.I.C.S.

Mr Kelly graduated in Rostrevor's Honours Class of 1928, five years after the College was founded. After obtaining a medical degree, he worked in residence at a children's hospital in Adelaide before venturing overseas to continue his studies at surgical schools in London and Dublin. Mr Kelly then worked as a surgeon for the remainder of his career, including a stint in Baghdad, becoming distinguished in his field. Mr Kelly named the bequeathment in honour of his late mother, Mrs Catherine Mary Enright Kelly, who he remembered as a great support in his life and career.

<p>Selection Criteria</p>	<p>The CMEK Scholarship is awarded to a new or existing student at Rostrevor College entering Year 7 who demonstrates high achievement and outstanding academic aptitude across all aspects of College life.</p> <p>The successful recipient will also demonstrate that he will respect the values underlying a Catholic School in the Edmund Rice Tradition.</p> <p>Candidates will be shortlisted and interviewed by a committee comprising of the Head of School, Director of Teaching & Learning and Rostrevor College Foundation Chair (or delegate). Recommendations will be made to the Principal before one student is selected as the successful Scholarship recipient. Only one new Scholarship of this type is awarded annually.</p>
<p>Benefits</p>	<p>This Scholarship includes a 25% remission of tuition fees for Years 7-9.</p>
<p>Expectations</p>	<p>Recipients of Scholarships at Rostrevor College are required to meet all other charges related to a student's education at the College. They include the balance of tuition fees, stationery, uniforms (including Co-Curricular uniforms) and the additional costs if the recipient chooses to participate in optional activities.</p> <p>Please note this scholarship does not provide remission of boarding fees.</p> <p>The prospective student and his family are required to respect the values underlying a Catholic School in the Edmund Rice Tradition. When accepting a Scholarship and a place at the College, the student and his family become members of the Rostrevor College community. It is understood that the acceptance of enrolment implies an undertaking on the part of the student, with the support of his family, to participate fully in all College activities as required.</p>

- A covering letter written by the student addressing the selection criteria. The letter should be addressed to the College Principal and suggested that it also cover the following:
 - Why the student has applied for this scholarship and (if applicable) why the student wishes to attend Rostrevor College.
 - The student's commitment to upholding Rostrevor's values and intention to participate in College life.
 - The student's performance in all subjects, including mention of any awards, achievements or Co-Curricular participation and involvement in any academic pursuits outside of school.
- Evidence of performance across all subjects at school, such as most recent end of year reports, NAPLAN results or awards.
- Optional evidence of involvement in academic pursuits outside of school, such as competitions, clubs or if the student is a tutor or mentor for younger peers.

Please confirm you meet the prerequisites for consideration for this scholarship opportunity:

- The applicant is an Australian Citizen and/or Permanent Resident.
- The applicant will be a day or boarding student in Year 7 in 2027 at Rostrevor College and (if applicable) an Enrolment Form has been completed.
- We understand the scholarship will cover 25% of tuition fees for Years 7-9.

Please note - incomplete applications will not be considered for shortlisting.
